Thousands of friends and colleagues gather for ICEF's flagship event

As international education continues to face the challenges of recovery, economic uncertainty, and digital transformation - ICEF Berlin 2022 was a celebration of our industry's resilience, adaptability, and innovation, as **2,460 friends and colleagues** came together from **114 countries**.

For 2,192 delegates it was an opportunity to network and catch up with old friends in person, at the InterContinental Hotel, while 268 joined online.

Together, over the course of three days, they held a total of **21,714 in-person and virtual meetings**.

For 10% of delegates this was their first time at an ICEF event, and for 11% their first time at ICEF Berlin.

Great Delegate Feedback

In our after-event survey, the reasons selected for attending ICEF Berlin were: to meet new partners, refresh contacts with existing ones, increase industry knowledge, and brand growth. By the time the event had finished, 92.8% of respondents stated they had already achieved some or all of their objectives.

90.7% of survey respondents rated the number of new contacts they made as good or excellent, and **90.3%** gave the same high rating to the quality of contacts.

The organisation of the event and the support and level of communication provided by the ICEF team, were rated as good or excellent by **96.8%** and **96.4%** of survey respondents, respectively.

For **97.2%** of respondents, it is 'very likely' that they will return to ICEF Berlin in the future.

We are grateful for the generous feedback and will work to ensure all ICEF events meet the same high standards to enable professional, productive, and efficient networking.

A total of **971 international educators** attended ICEF Berlin 2022. 923 travelled to Germany to join in person at the InterContinental Hotel, while 48 joined remotely.

8% were attending their first ICEF event, while for 11% it was their first time at ICEF Berlin.

Together they represented **593 organisations** from **40 countries**.

Student Recruitment Agents

Confirming its position as the global agent networking event of the year, ICEF Berlin 2022 welcomed **1,101 agents** from **104 countries**. 891 joined in person, 210 virtually, and together they represented **908 organisations**.

In total, 693 agents, or 63%, held top management positions. For 10% this was their first ICEF event, and for 12%, their first time at the flagship event in Berlin.

ICEF events provide an ideal opportunity for providers of services related to international student mobility to connect, one-to-one, with educators and agents representing hundreds of thousands of overseas students.

As our industry undergoes a digital transformation, at recent events we have witnessed both an increase in providers attending, and a more diverse range of services being showcased.

At ICEF Berlin 2022, **260 service providers** from **119 organisations** attended, an increase of 162% over last year. They came from **22 countries**, and together they represented **22 service sectors** ranging from accommodation providers, telecommunications and student counselling, to a wide selection of digital tools and services, including recruitment and accommodation platforms, CRM systems and school/agency software.

For 16% this was their first time attending an ICEF event, and for 15%, this was the first time at ICEF Berlin.
